

## TWISTED EASEL CARD



- In Bloom Stamp Set
- Pierced Blooms Dies
- Night of Navy Cardstock
  - Cut 4 1/4" x 8 1/2" - Score at 4 1/4", then score from top left corner to middle 4 1/4" score line.
  - Cut 3" x 3" for Largest Scalloped Square or cut 2 3/4" x 2 3/4"
  - Scraps for flowers and leaves
- Seaside Spray Cardstock
  - Cut 2 pieces 4" x 4"
  - Scraps for flowers & leaves
- Paper Blooms DSP - Cut 3 3/4" x 3 3/4"
- Basic White Cardstock
  - Cut 3 3/4" x 3 3/4"
  - Cut 2 5/8" x 2 5/8" (if using Largest Scalloped Square) or 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- Rococo Rose Cardstock - scraps for flowers
- Ink: Night of Navy
- Adhesive: Stampin' Seal, Dimensionals, Glue Dots
- Tools: Paper Trimmer, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine

DIRECTIONS:

1. Using Night of Navy Ink, stamp sentiment at bottom of 3 ¾" x 3 ¾" piece of Basic White Cardstock. Adhere to 4" x 4" piece of Seaside Mist Cardstock. Adhere to inside of card base
2. Adhere 3 ¾" x 3 ¾" piece of DSP to 4"x 4" piece of Seaside Mist Cardstock.
3. Using Night of Navy Ink, stamp sentiment at bottom of 2 ½" x 2 ½" piece of Basic White Cardstock.
4. Adhere to Night of Navy Scalloped Square, then adhere to center of DSP/Seaside Mist Square.
5. Use glue dots to adhere flower centers to flowers., Then using dimensionals and adhesive arrange flowers along top of sentiment piece as shown.
6. To adhere above piece to card front
  - a. Close card with front flap folded back.
  - b. Place Adhesive on the triangle flap about ¼" from the edge.
  - c. With the flap folded, place front panel square on top, lining it up with the square on the inside of the card.
7. Use one small flower on dimensionals to attach to the inside just above the sentiment. To test where to place the flower, open the card and then place in the appropriate spot as shown. This will hold the front flap in place for display.
